2nd Round Instructions

Guidelines for Second Round of Online Admission 2024 [As per DHE Instructions]

Application Period: The SAMARTH portal is open for online applications from July 02, 2024, until midnight on July 07, 2024.

Student Registration:

1. Students who have already registered on the portal during the first round do not need to re-register. They can directly apply to other colleges available for the second round.
2. Students who did not register during the first round of admission can complete new registrations on the SAMARTH portal during this period.

Entrance Test:

The Entrance Test & Merit List procedures for the Admission (**Round 2**) to FY B.Voc.(Software Technologies) programme at VVM's Shree Damodar College of Commerce & Economics are mentioned below.

Weightage for Preparing the Merit List

The merit list to be prepared based on following mentioned schemes

1. **B.Voc.(Software Technologies) Programme**
 - a. **12th Marks** - 40% weightage
 - b. **Entrance Test Score** - 30% weightage
 - c. **Interview** - 30% weightage

Entrance Test

- The Entrance Test for admission to be based on the scheme and syllabus mentioned in **point numbers A, B, and C on next page.**
- The **Personal Interview** to be conducted on the same day of the Entrance Exam.
- **Entrance Test Centre:** VVM's Shree Damodar College of Commerce & Economics, Margao - Goa
- **Entrance Test Day & Date : Tuesday, 09th July 2024 (Tentative, may change)**
- The actual Date & Time of the Test will be **emailed to the applicants on their email ids** (i.e. email id mentioned by the applicant at the time of online application / form filling through samarth portal) and it will also be **displayed on the admission details page of our College website.**

A. Entrance Test Details

1. Test Day & Date: **Tuesday, 09th July 2024. (Tentative, may change)**
2. Test Time / Slot : Final Date & Time will be informed through email / displayed on our website
3. Test Type: Multiple Choice Questions, No Negative Marking
4. Total Questions: 50 (2 marks each) ; Total Marks: 100
5. Test Duration : 75 minutes
6. There will be 4 sections as follows-
 - a. Section A - Quantitative Aptitude - 15 Questions
 - b. Section B - Logical Reasoning - 15 Questions
 - c. Section C - Computer Awareness - 10 Questions
 - d. Section D - General Knowledge - 10 Questions

B. Tie-Breaking Rules –

After considering all the weightage components together, if the merit rank of students are in the situation of tie, then the merit rank to be decided based on the rules mentioned below.

The following rules to be applied in the order given below when there is a tie –

- 1) Student having higher score in the **Entrance Test component** shall be ranked higher.
- 2) Student having higher score in the **12th Marks component** shall be ranked higher.
- 3) Student having higher score in the **Section B: Logical Reasoning** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 4) Student having higher score in the **Section A: Quantitative Aptitude** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 5) Student having higher score in the **Section C: Computer Awareness** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 6) Student having higher score in the **Section D: General Knowledge** of the Aptitude Test component shall be ranked higher.
- 7) If the tie still exists, then decision to be taken by the Admission committee of the respective college and the same to be indicated in the ranking list.

3. Basic knowledge of Web Browser, Websites, Social Media, Email - 3 Questions
4. Basic knowledge of Virus, Worms, Spam, Trojans and Anti-Virus - 2 Questions
